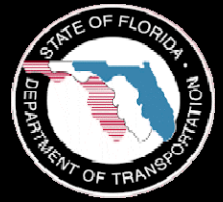


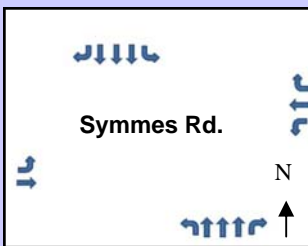
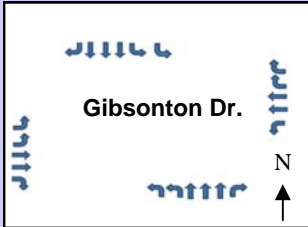

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) contractor, Prince Contracting, is widening US 301 between Gibsonton Dr. and Balm Rd. from a two lane road to a six lane divided highway with raised medians.

The project also includes building a new five foot sidewalk on the west side of the road, a 12 foot multi-use path on the east side, and new street lighting on both sides of the road.

Work Schedule

The \$61 million dollar project began in November 2008 and is anticipated to take 3^{1/2} years to complete.

Currently, the contractor is working primarily from the south to the north on the east side of US 301. Work includes clearing the FDOT right of way, installing new drainage and water pipes, building new ponds, constructing the new northbound roadway and building the multi-use path. This phase of the work is expected to take approximately two years.

Once the work is complete on the east side, traffic will be switched to the new northbound lanes, and the contractor will work on the west side of US 301 rebuilding the southbound roadway, completing the drainage work and constructing the sidewalk.

The majority of the work is being done outside of the travel lanes. However, work requiring lane closures will be limited to 8:30 pm to 7:00 am.
