Governed by a Board of Supervisors

Responsibilities include construction, financing & maintenance of the community infrastructure:

- * Common grounds and landscaping
- * Ponds/Lakes
- * Recreations Facilities, Parks & Courts
- * Entrance Way, Street Lighting
- * CDD related Financial and Administrative issues

How are fees paid?

Owners are assessed through their annual property tax bill in the form of a non-ad valorem assessment. This has two parts:
Annual Debt Service Fee
Annual Operations & Maintenance Fee
